DHF Training and Lessons Policies and Pricing

Dancing Horse Farm offers Practical lessons in Dressage and Eventing as well as Theory lessons to enable our students to become truly educated equestrians.

1. Appropriate riding attire is required for all lesson participants. **An ASTM/SEI certified riding helmet with buckled chin strap is required for all riders.** DHF's preferred lesson attire consists of a short or long sleeved shirt, breeches with paddock boots and half chaps, or tall boots. Long hair should always be neatly contained for safety reasons. Tank tops, sports bras, and tube tops are considered to be inappropriate attire for lessons.

2. 24 hour notice is required to cancel or reschedule a lesson without incurring the "No-show" fee which is equivalent to the cost of the missed lesson.

3. DHF's instructors make every effort to adhere to the lesson schedule as it is agreed upon by the instructor and student. Students must allow at least 30-45 minutes prior to their scheduled lesson time to catch from the field, groom and tack up their horse. Students should be mounted and in the arena at the scheduled time for their lesson or forfeit the portion of their lesson they missed by running late. Students are responsible for cooling down and grooming their lesson horse, **cleaning DHF's tack/equipment**, and returning everything to its proper place.

4. DHF only accepts payments by cash or check for lessons and payment must be remitted the day of service or purchased in advance. If purchasing in advance, a Punch Card system is put in place. In the Indoor, there will be a file for each participant. Once a lesson is complete, the instructor will initial the card and you will be notified when it is time to purchase more. A \$20 returned check fee applies if a check doesn't clear.

5. Cancellation/Make-up Policy: Student has 60 days in which to make up a prepaid lesson or forfeit the fees associated with the missed lesson(s).

6. Classical Dressage Instruction with Jennifer Truett, USDF Bronze Medalist, Bronze Freestyle Bar recipient and winner of multiple USDF Regional Championships:

- a. Private: \$50
- b. Discounted Weekly Package: \$125 for 3 private lessons per calendar week
- c. Semi-private (2 students): \$40 per student
- d. Groups (up to four riders in one lesson): \$35 per student

7. Eventing and Beginner Riding Lessons with Lindsay Lechner, Pony Club Graduate B:

- a. Private: \$40
- b. Discounted Weekly Package: \$100 for 3 private lessons per calendar week
- c. Semi-private (2 students): \$30 per student
- d. Groups (up to four riders in one lesson): \$25 per student

8. Training packages: Packages can be completed in three ways: the trainer can ride your horse in a training session or you can ride your horse or a DHF school horse in a lesson

i. Full Training (5 days per week): \$800 + full care board

ii. Partial Training (3 days per week): \$500 + full care board

b. Lindsay Lechner

i. Full Training (5 days per week): \$650 + full care board

ii. Partial Training (3 days per week): \$400 + full care board
