DHF Camp Policies

Dancing Horse Farm offers Practical lessons in Dressage and Eventing as well as Theory lessons to enable our students to become truly educated equestrians. For the summer, we offer weeklong camps for beginner through advanced students.

1. Appropriate riding attire is required for all camp participants. **An ASTM/SEI certified riding helmet with buckled chinstrap is required for all riders.** DHF's preferred riding attire consists of a short or long sleeved shirt, breeches with paddock boots and half chaps, or tall boots. Long hair should always be neatly contained for safety reasons. Tank tops, sports bras, and tube tops are considered to be inappropriate attire.

2. DHF only accepts payments by cash or check for camp. A \$50 deposit must be remitted with registration. The deposit is non-refundable. Campers with balance due will not be able to participate in camp. A \$50 returned check fee applies if a check does not clear. Furthermore:

1. Pre-paid registration is required and must be RECEIVED 7 business days prior to all camp programs. This is the "closing date" for camp.
2. You have until the closing date to cancel or change your registration. The deposit is non-refundable.
3. Changes made after the closing date will be accepted if substitute is provided. If no substitute is found, no fees will be refunded.

3. Drop off: Campers must be dropped off between 8:45 and 9:00 am. Tardiness is not only disruptive to fellow campers, but campers lose valuable instruction time with their horses/ponies.

Pick Up: Campers must be picked-up promptly at 1:00pm, thereafter DHF camp is not staffed. If campers are not picked up by 1:00 there will be a \$10 charge per 20 minutes late.

4. Camp Confirmation: A phone call will be placed to each camper the week prior to each camp for confirmation, introduction and to go over camp expectations. Required forms status and balance due will be reviewed:
